

Grade GPA Calculation worksheet

How to calculate your semester, major, or institution Grade Point Average (GPA):

1. Turn course grades into grade points by multiplying the numerical value of a grade earned by the credit hours for that class.

For example, a grade of a B+ in a 3-unit class would be worth 3.3×3 , which equals 9.9 grade points or Quality-Points.

2. Add all of your Quality-Points together.
 - To calculate semester GPA, only use grades for the semester.
 - To calculate major GPA, only use grades counting towards your major.
 - To calculate institution GPA, use all courses attempted at HSU.

3. Divide this number by the total number of GPA hours attempted.
 - Total quality-Points / Hours Attempted = Grade Point Average

*Notes:

- Do not include remedial courses (indicated by a # sign on HSU transcripts) in GPA.
- For courses repeated at HSU, use only the most recent grade in calculating GPA.
- An "I" (incomplete) turns to an "F" if not completed within a year.
